RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All persons wishing to compete for prizes in the Hall Sections must have their entries and entry forms to the pavilion from **1pm to 6pm on Thursday 9 March** and not later than **12pm Friday 10th March 2017** as per each section in the schedule. No late entries will be accepted. Judging of exhibits will be on Friday.
2. All exhibitors and parents or guardians of children 16 and under must sign an entry form for each section they enter.
3. Entry cards must be securely attached to each exhibit. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of, grown by, or the work of the exhibitor.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any damage or breakage or loss of any exhibit, and all persons competing in all Sections do so at their own risk.
5. The decision of the Stewards in case of any dispute will be final. No prize will be awarded in any class unless, in the Judge's opinion, the exhibit merits it. No tied prizes will be awarded.
6. "Most Successful Exhibitor" chosen as follows: 3 points for category champion, 2 points for 1st and 1 point for 2nd.
7. In the case of two or more people gaining equal points for the "Most Successful Exhibitor" in each section, any prize vouchers will be converted to cash and divided equally between the winners. The prize for the Most Successful Exhibitor in a pavilion will only be awarded if ten or more points for prizes have been awarded in that pavilion.
8. To claim prizes, exhibitors must collect their entry form and prize cards from the Steward and sign out on the entry form, then take the entry form to the Showground Office for collection on **Saturday 11th March from 2:30pm**. No exhibits may be removed from display before 2:30pm Saturday.
9. Goods cannot be sold by the exhibitor until after 2:30pm after being cleared by the Steward and entry form signed.
10. All monies or vouchers not claimed or arranged for by **1st April 2017** will be used to help finance next year's event.
11. Protests against any exhibits awarded a prize must be in writing and lodged with the Secretary within 24 hours of the award being made public, accompanied with a deposit of \$5 which shall be forfeited to the Association if the matter of the protest is considered frivolous by the Committee. The owner of the exhibit thus protested against shall be summoned to meet the Committee at a time and place mentioned in the summons and if he or she fails to attend or make reasonable excuse for his or her absence, he or she shall forfeit his or her right to the prize. No appeal shall be entered into where there are no grounds of appeal other than the decision of the judges.
12. In the event of the Comboyne Show having to be abandoned, a decision will be made at a meeting of the President, Ring Master and Assistant Ring Master and entry fees only to be refunded.
13. The Committee reserve the right to add or delete any event or rearrange the program as required.
