**Rules** Amateur photographers only may exhibit. Limit of 3 entries per person, per class.  
 Photographs are to be mounted on black cardboard with a 25mm border around the image.  
 Photographs are to be no smaller than 100mm x 150mm and no larger than 300mm x 200mm  
 Please include class, category, photographer's name and phone number on the back of each photograph.

**Criteria** All entries will be judged based on picture quality, lighting, sharpness of subject and how well it captures and tells the story of the subject.

**Prizes** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize cards for each class. First prize exhibit from each class awarded a \$20 voucher.  
 Juniors awarded a \$10 cash first prize for each class. Most Successful Junior exhibitor - \$20 cash. Most Successful Open Exhibitor (based on points) - \$50 cash.

**Open Photography Category (colour, black and white or monotone)**

Class	Description	Qty
1.	<b>Portraits</b> - Individual with head and shoulder with focus on the eyes (use portrait photo orientation). Family or group portraits with everyone in focus (either portrait or landscape orientation) Attention paid to background.	
2.	<b>People in Action</b> - Including sports and photojournalism.	
3.	<b>Landscapes and Nature</b> - Capture the beauty of the mid north coast and hinterland. Unspoilt pristine landscape from the ocean to the mountains, can include bridges.	
4.	<b>Wildlife and Birds</b> - Capture Australian wildlife including feral animals, but not pets.	
5.	<b>Travel</b> - Taken outside the Mid North Coast, camping holiday, city trip or visit to another culture.	
6.	<b>Architectural Landscape</b> - Create a landscape scene, with an emphasis on rural & historical buildings. This may include modern architecture with significant design features.	
7.	<b>Rural Life</b> - In and around community, life on the farm, with emphasis on rural storytelling.	
8.	<b>Arts and Music</b> - An artist at work or a musician practicing or performing.	
9.	<b>Artistic Expression</b> - Using the background & the subject, convey an artistic mood, e.g. silhouette. This class includes but is not restricted to digital manipulation and montage.	
10.	<b>Macro or Close-up</b> - Including but not restricted to insects and flowers.
