## **RULES & REGULATIONS (related to Junior Exhibitors)**

1. All persons wishing to compete for prizes in the Hall Sections must have their entries and entry forms to the pavilion as per each section in the schedule. No late entries will be accepted. **Judging** of exhibits will be from 12pm on **Friday 23rd February 2018**.
2. All exhibitors must submit their entry with a signed entry form for each section they enter. Children 16 and under must include the indemnity clause signed by a parent or guardian on their entry form for each section, or use the adult entry form with the junior indemnity form attached.
3. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of, grown by, or the work of the exhibitor.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any damage or breakage or loss of any exhibit, and all persons competing in all Sections do so at their own risk.
5. The decision of the Stewards in case of any dispute will be final. No prize will be awarded in any class unless, in the Judge's opinion, the exhibit merits it. No tied prizes will be awarded.
6. Championship Prizes awarded based on a point score will be calculated as follows: Category winner = 3 points; 1<sup>st</sup> = 2 points. In the event of a tied point score, an extra point for each exhibit entered by each championship contender will be factored in to the tally.
7. For the purposes of the 2018 Show championship tally, entries exhibited in the Billabong will be considered as part of the Art Pavilion.
8. Exhibits can be claimed or sold by the exhibitor from 3:00 pm. after the entry form has been collected from the Steward and signed off.
9. To claim prizes, exhibitors must collect their prize cards from the Steward to take to the Showground Office for collection on **Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> February from 2:00pm**.
10. All monies or vouchers not claimed or arranged for by **1<sup>st</sup> April 2018** will be used to help finance next year's event.
11. Protest made against any exhibits awarded a prize must be in writing and lodged with the Secretary within 24 hours of the award being made public, accompanied with a deposit of \$5 which shall be forfeited to the Association if the matter of the protest is considered frivolous by the Committee. If the protest is upheld by the Committee, the protester shall be summoned to meet the Committee at a time and place mentioned in the summons and if he or she fails to attend or make reasonable excuse for his or her absence, he or she shall forfeit his or her right to the prize. No appeal shall be entered into where there are no grounds of appeal other than the decision of the judges.
